### How to use

- · Before use, carefully read the directions on the packaging and act accordingly
- The aerosol should have room temperature.
- Best processing temperature 10 to 25°C.
- Before use, shake the aerosol.
- Search the cause of the leakage and remove this. Completely let the tyre down. Screw the adaptor on the
  valve.
- Hold the can upside down and empty completely
- In order to enable the product to equally spread in the tyre, directly drive about ten minutes. Then remove the propellant from the tyre and again bring the tyre on pressure.
- When repairing the tyre, please indicate the tyre was temporarily repaired with Tyre Repair.
- Suitable to repair small leakages in the tyre.
